Spare Change Jars: Place empty jars around your office, on your desk or near gathering places. Add a little sign explaining our cause and ask employees to deposit spare change. This can be a competition between employees or departments to see who can collect the most change.

Guess The Number: Fill a clear jar with candy and have employees pay for a chance to guess the number of pieces in the jar. The most accurate wins the jar of candy.
